A WORD FROM YOUR POLICE DEPARTMENT

Keeping Kids Safe on Halloween

Always trick or treat with an adult.

Only trick or treat in familiar areas that are well lit.

Cross streets at corners.

Make eye contact with drivers and watch for cars that are turning or backing up.

Walk on sidewalks or paths. If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible.

Wear light-colored, flame retardant costumes decorated with reflective tape or stickers.

Wear well fitting, sturdy shoes to prevent trips and falls.

Carry a flashlight or glow stick to increase visibility to drivers.

Wear face paint and makeup. A mask can restrict a child's vision.

Drive Safely on Halloween

Drive more slowly and anticipate heavy pedestrian traffic.

Be sure to drive with your headlights on so you can spot children.

Take time to actively look for kids at intersections and on sides of roads.

Remember costumes can limit children's visibility and they may not be able to see your vehicle.

Enter and exit driveways slowly and carefully.

Remember children are excited on this night and may move in unpredictable ways.





CONTACTING YOUR LOCAL POLICE DEPARTMENT

Monroe County Dispatch Phone Number (Non Emergency Police) 734-243-7070 In case of Emergency, Dial 911

It has been noted that citizens have recently become dependent on contacting the Police Department via the general office phone.

Although it is ok to contact us using the office phone, if there is something happening that needs attention by an officer, the best and quickest way to get in contact with someone from the Police Department is through Central Dispatch.

In the case of an emergency always dial 911.

The Monroe County Central Dispatch center is always in constant radio contact with our on duty officer.

734-243-7070 is the number you should call if you need a police officer sent to your house for non-emergency services.

Please make note of this number so that you may better activate and utilize the services that your Police Department provides.

Gun safety is very important!


We provide gun locks for FREE here at the Village Hall. Feel free to come in and pick one up during normal business hours.



RUBBISH PICKUP

by 6:00am, as recycle collection is very early.

Make sure ALL your garbage is placed IN A BAG.

This prevents loose garbage from falling onto the roadway and into our yards when the garbage company dumps the cans.



In the event that your garbage falls on the ground, please pick it up and bag it so we can keep our community clean.

**Please remember that Ord-35,102 Section 2. states that rubbish containers shall be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00pm on the day before collection day and all containers must be taken in before 8:00pm on the day of collection and placed out of general view.

This includes recycle totes.

Totes & trash cans damaged by traffic will be replaced at the expense of the homeowner.

Leaves and brush are only picked up on the

2nd and 4th Mondays of the month.

Have your yard waste out by 8:00am.

We will only travel the road once.

Please have cut ends of branches facing the road edge for easier disposal.

No thorns or poison ivy/oak.

Do not put dirt in bags.

Any bag over 50 lbs will be left behind.



The Village Hall will no longer be carrying lawn and leaf bags for purchase.

You can purchase **biodegradable bags** from your local hardware store.

Ingredients:

- °1 stick butter or margarine
- °1 tsp milk
- °1 C. sugar
- °1 C. of flour
- °1 C. baking powder
- ^oPinch of salt
- °1 pint. sweet fruits (peaches, cherries, blackberries, etc.)

*Directions:

Melt butter in a baking dish.

Blend flour, sugar, baking powder, salt & milk.

SNOW REMOVAL

Seniors and/or disabled residents may be eligible for snow removal services IF you meet the following requirements:

- · You must be 65 years and/or disabled,
- And have no additional persons residing with you that are able to shovel snow.
- You must provide a doctor's slip confirming your disability.

**If you have been on the snow removal list in the past, applications will be going out soon.

Please make sure that you fill out **BOTH forms** in the application packet— the application and the waiver.

If you have any questions or would like to be added to the snow removal list, please feel free to contact the Village Hall.





If there are four or more inches of snow, it is considered a snow emergency and cars are not allowed to park in the road right-of-way. Vehicles parked in the right-of-way during a snow emergency will be towed.

To confirm that a snow emergency is in effect, listen to WJR or WWJ.

We ask that property owners use caution when plowing or removing snow from your driveways. **PUSHING SNOW INTO THE STREET IS A VIOLATION OF LAW.**

Section 257.677A (4) of the Michigan Penal Code and Motor Vehicle Law states "A person shall not deposit, or cause to be deposited, snow, ice, or slush on any roadway or highway."
